The Flex-M Study

We are conducting a clinical research study to test the safety and effectiveness of an investigational medication when it is used with methotrexate for patients with rheumatoid arthritis (RA).

You may be able to participate in the Flex-M Study if you:

- are 18 years of age or older
- have been diagnosed with RA for at least 6 months
- have been receiving methotrexate for at least 12 weeks
- have symptoms of active RA such as painful, stiff, and swollen joints.

The Flex-M Study will last for up to 152 weeks. You will continue to take methotrexate throughout the study. The study will require regular visits to the study center so that the study doctors and nurses can monitor your RA symptoms and general health.

Taking part in the Flex-M Study will provide new information that will add to the current knowledge about RA treatment, which may potentially help other patients in the future.
